We look forward to our Valentine's Day party on Wednesday, February 14th. Your child can bring in cards for all students in their class. The teachers will be sending a separate home more information soon.

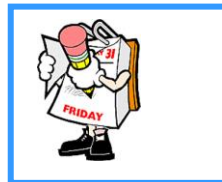
